GEORGIA EXPORTS CONTINUE TO ACCELERATE IN 2023

International Trade supports jobs, diversifies revenue, and bolsters economic resilience across Georgia. Export values set a new record in 2023, exceeding 2022's totals by 5% and marking a third year of record exports. While U.S. exports have decreased overall, Georgia exports have experienced sustained growth for the last decade, increasing 26% since 2014.

Sixty-seven percent of exports and 71% of total trade involved the strategic markets where Georgia's international representatives connect local exporters to global opportunities.

Georgia remains the seventh largest state in the U.S. for total trade, spanning 222 unique countries and territories. Georgia's air and sea ports serve as global gateways, facilitating more than \$186.3 billion in total trade with the world in 2023.




